This is such a fun and easy sew! Pick your main focus fabric and a few coordinating fabrics... you're good to go!

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS



Color A - (x|6) 6.5" Squares
Color B - (x7) 7"' Squares
Color A - (x5) 7" Squares I FAT QUARTER
Color A - ( $x 5$ ) 7" Squares
I FAT QUARTER I FAT QUARTER

## Color A - (x4) 7" Squares I FAT QUARTER

## BACKING - I I/4"YARD FABRIC OF CHOICE BINDING -I/4YARD FABIC OF CHOICE

## MAKE HST (HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES) - TWO AT A TIME



1. Place 2 fabric pieces (see pairings page 3) - right sides together. Pin in place.
2. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. (This will also be your cut line)
3. Sew a line $1 / 4$ " on either side of the drawn line.
4. Cut the sewn square on the drawn diagonal line.
5. Press your HST open. Press seams open or towards the darker fabric.
6. Trim to a 6.5 " square.
