# SWEET BABY QUILT PATTERN



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# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS




BACKING - I 1/4" YARD FABRIC OF CHOICE BINDING - I/4YARD FABIC OF CHOICE

#### MAKE HST (HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES) - TWO AT A TIME

- 1. Place 2 fabric pieces (see pairings page 3) right sides together. Pin in place.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. (This will also be your cut line)
- 3. Sew a line 1/4" on either side of the drawn line.
- 4. Cut the sewn square on the drawn diagonal line.
- 5. Press your HST open. Press seams open or towards the darker fabric.
- 6. Trim to a 6.5" square.

### NUMBER OF HST YOU SHOULD HAVE:




\*This number includes one extra HST that will not be used on the quilt top.

## ASSEMBLE THE QUILT TOP:

Assemble the squares into rows. Press each row in opposite directions to nest the seams. Sew together rowsand press entire quilt top.

Tip: Don't forget the back and binding! Do something fun or unexpected with them too!



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
