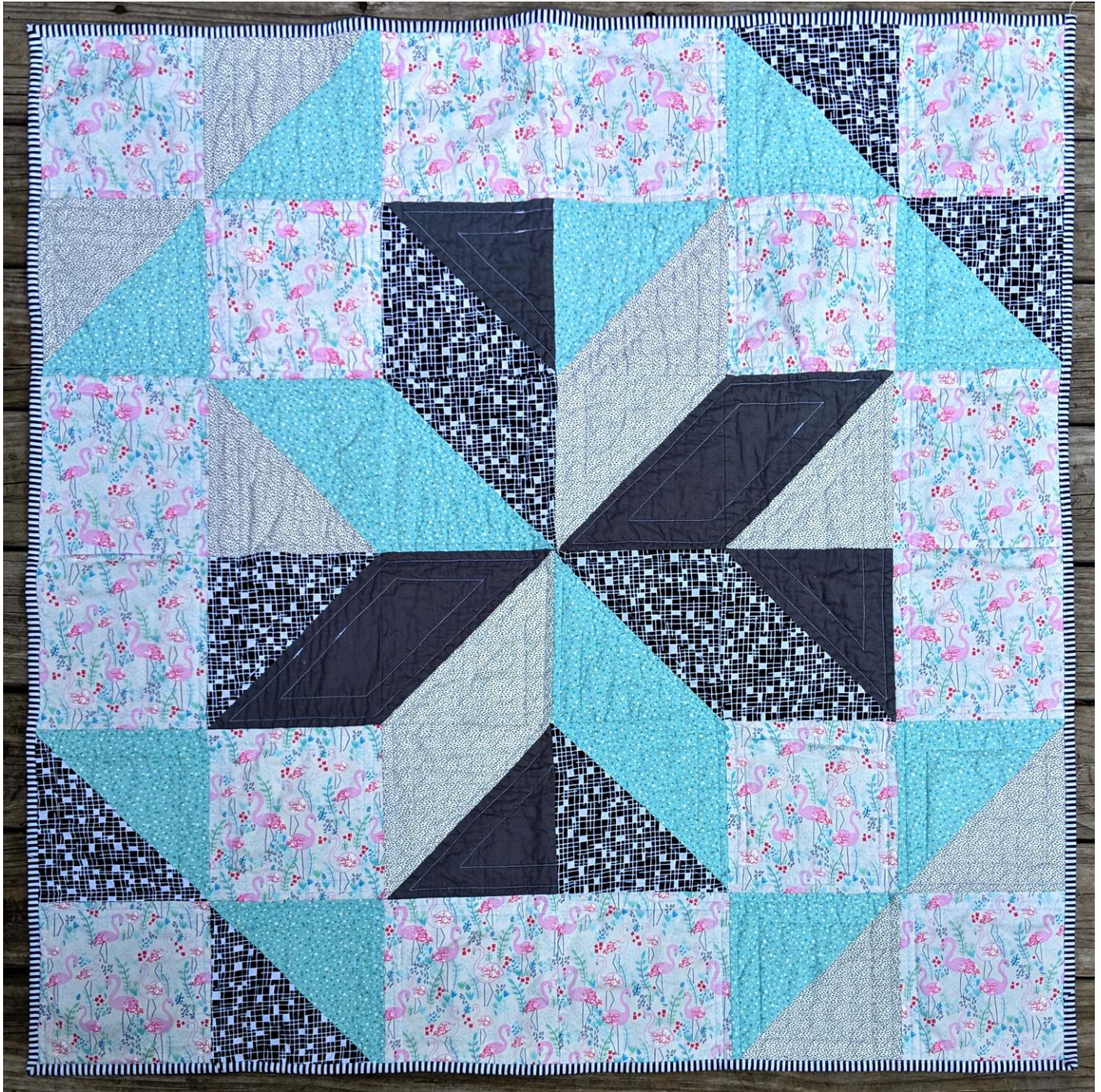


# SWEET BABY QUILT PATTERN

FINISHED SIZE IS 36" x 36"



This is such a fun and easy sew! Pick your main focus fabric and a few coordinating fabrics... you're good to go!

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS



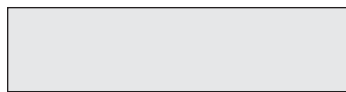
Color A - (x16) 6.5" Squares  
3/4 YARD



Color B - (x7) 7" Squares  
1/2 YARD



Color A - (x5) 7" Squares  
1 FAT QUARTER



Color A - (x5) 7" Squares  
1 FAT QUARTER



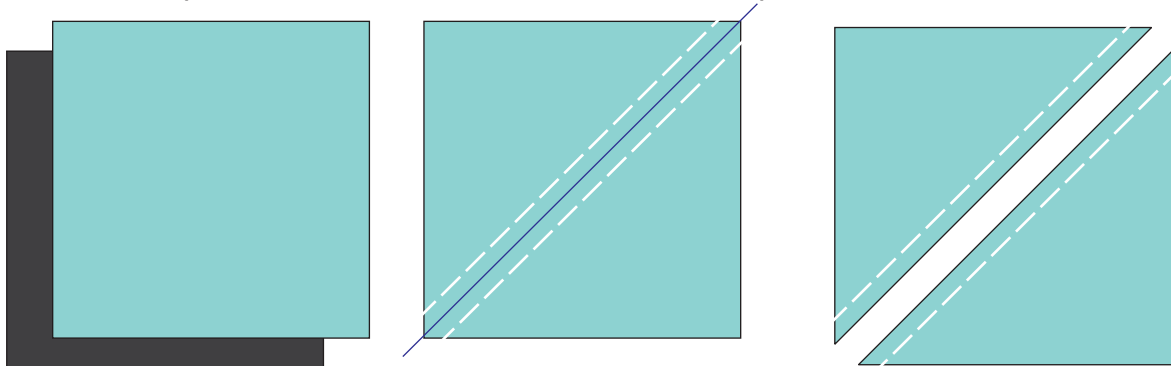
Color A - (x4) 7" Squares  
1 FAT QUARTER

BACKING - 1 1/4" YARD FABRIC OF CHOICE

BINDING - 1/4 YARD FABRIC OF CHOICE

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### MAKE HST (HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES) - TWO AT A TIME



1. Place 2 fabric pieces (see pairings page 3) - right sides together. Pin in place.
2. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. (This will also be your cut line)
3. Sew a line 1/4" on either side of the drawn line.
4. Cut the sewn square on the drawn diagonal line.
5. Press your HST open. Press seams open or towards the darker fabric.
6. Trim to a 6.5" square.

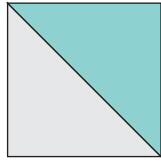
## NUMBER OF HST YOU SHOULD HAVE:



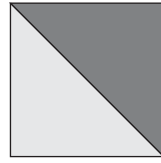

## ASSEMBLE THE QUILT TOP:

Assemble the squares into rows. Press each row in opposite directions to nest the seams. Sew together rows and press entire quilt top.

Tip: Don't forget the back and binding! Do something fun or unexpected with them too!
