

WALKER - CARRY ALL - PATTERN

You can use all the same fabric on this project or you can add a pop of fun to the lining of the pockets for a fun twist.

REQUIREMENTS:

Main Fabric - (4) 18" x 12"

(4) 12" x 4" (optional)

Or use (4) 12" ribbon pieces

(1) 18" x 10"

(1) 18" x 6"

(2) 4.5" x 3.5"

Lining Fabric - (1) 18" x 6"

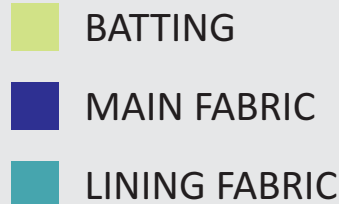
(1) 18" x 10"

Optional Batting Pieces*

(2) 12" x 18"

(1) 18" x 6"

(1) 18" x 10"



*Note - The batting isn't a requirement, but it does make for more sturdy pockets that hold their shape

DIRECTIONS:

1. Sew your pocket pieces as shown below. (Make sure to line your pieces up exactly on top of one another. The image below shows the order of fabric.)

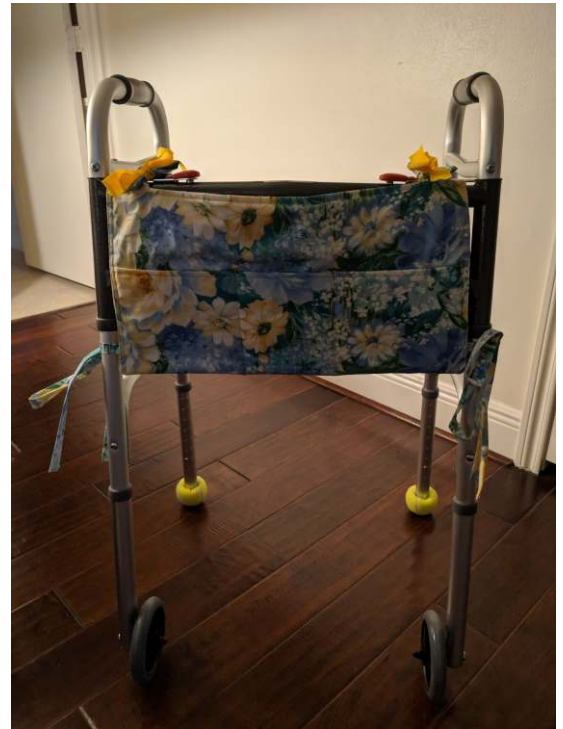
MAKE SURE FABRICS ARE RST

Sew a 1/4" Around the outside of your pocket leaving about a 4" gap open for turning your pocket right side out.

Do this for both pockets.

One pocket will measure 18" x 10" - pre-sewn

The other pocket will measure 18" x 6" - pre-sewn

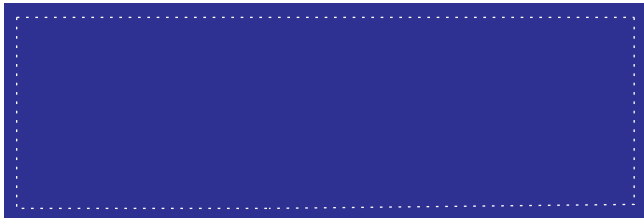


A PEEK INSIDE THE BACK...



2. Turn your pocket right side out. Make sure to poke your corners so they are crisp 90 degree corners. A chinese take-out chopstick is a really handy tool for this.

3. Stitch a 1/4" seam around the entire edge.



4. Do the same thing with your bigger project pieces that are 18" x 12" Line up your fabrics exactly and stitch 1/4" around leaving about a 4" gap across the bottom to turn your piece. Also leave a few more open areas for the connective straps across the top.



5. Turn your piece right side out and poke your corners so they are crisp 90 degree corners.

6. Pull out your strap pieces and press in half.

Then fold the sides inward and press again.

Sew a 1/4" seam down both sides to secure .

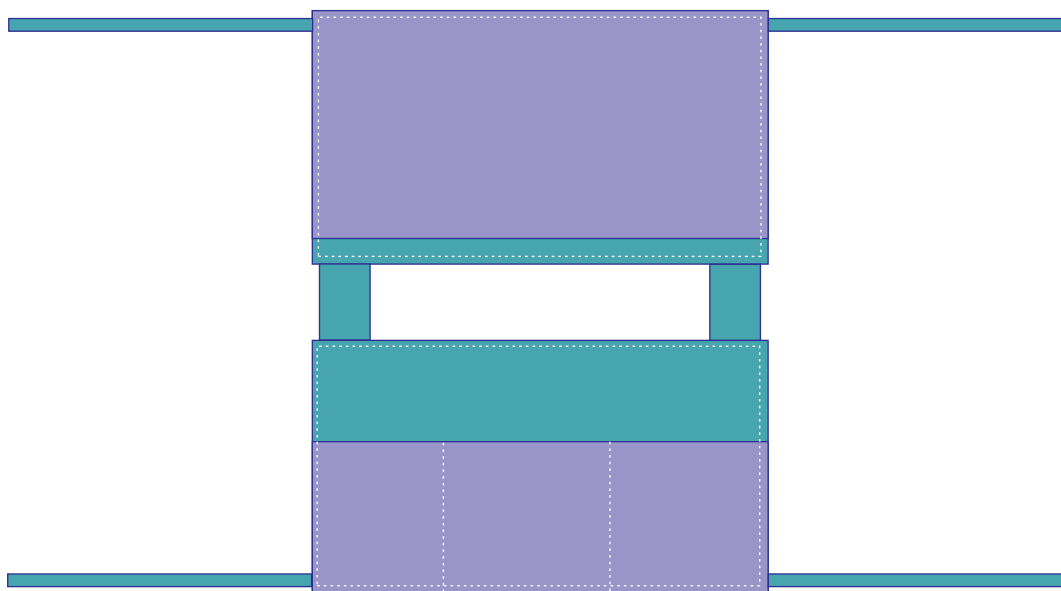


7. Follow the same steps in #6 to sew your tie straps.

You're in the home stretch... keep going!

8. Lay out your pieces as shown below. Put a pin in place to hold your straps until you stitch to secure them.

Stitch along the white lines shown below..



9. It's time to embellish! This is my favorite part! You can see in the photos that I added little yellow bows across the top straps. Make your walker bag custom for the person who will be using it.

Look into: patches, strings or ribbons, pins, fun fabric etc.
