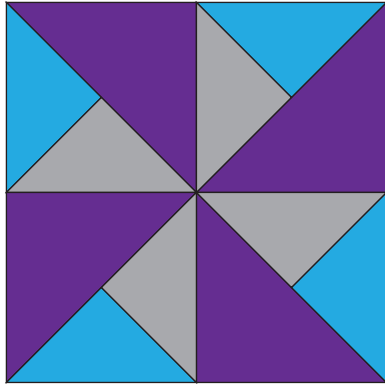


# Project Brighten




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## Block #1

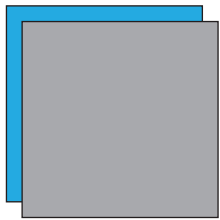


FINISHED SIZE: 12.5" X 12.5"

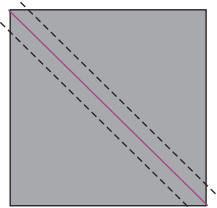
### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

-  (2) - 7" SQUARES
-  (1) - 7.5" SQUARE
-  (1) - 7.5" SQUARE

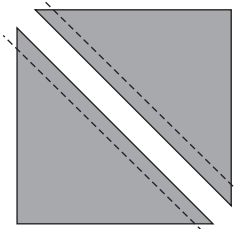
### SEWING HST (HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES)



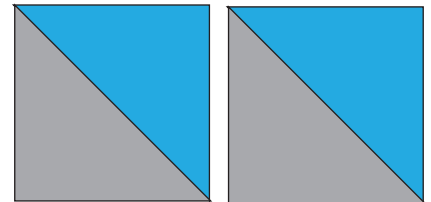
Layer 1 each of the 7" squares RST making sure to line up each side.



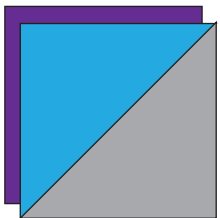
Using a fabric marker, draw a line from one corner to the other. Sew 1/4" either side of the line.



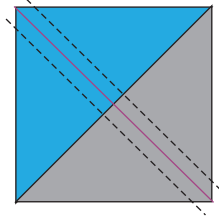
Cut on the center line.



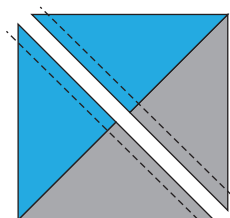
Press your seams.



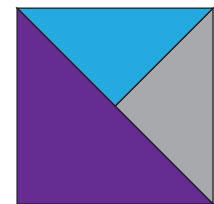
Layer your finished HST with the solid fabric square.



Using a fabric marker, draw a line from one corner to the other. Sew 1/4" either side of the line.



Cut on the center line.



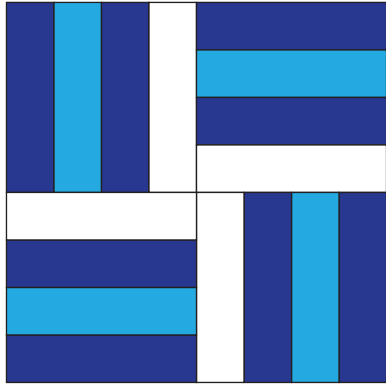
Press your seams. Assemble your blocks like the example and sew together with a 1/4" seam!

Square your block to be 12.5"

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# Block #2



FINISHED SIZE: 12.5" X 12.5"

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

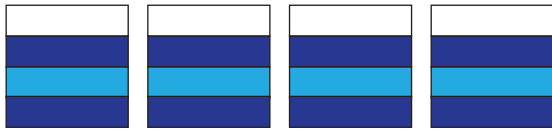
(4) - 2" X 26"  
STRIPS OF FABRIC

-OR-

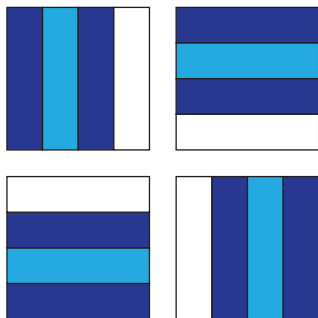
(16) - 2" X 6.5"  
STRIPS OF FABRIC



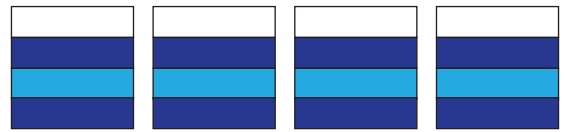
Sew your long 26" strips  
together using a 1/4" seam.



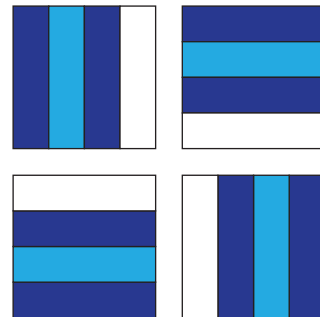
Cut into (4) equal strips at 6.5"



Rotate your strips.  
Sew together with a 1/4" seam.



Separate your strips into 4 sets of 4 strips each.  
Sew together using a 1/4" seam.

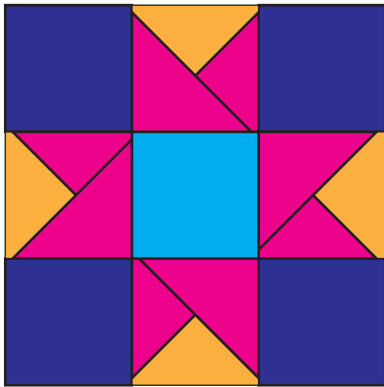


Rotate your strips.  
Sew together with a 1/4" seam.

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## Block #3

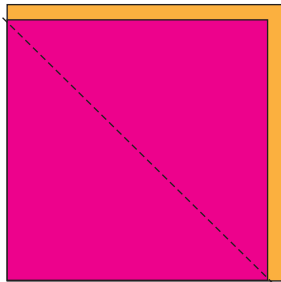


FINISHED SIZE: 12.5" X 12.5"

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

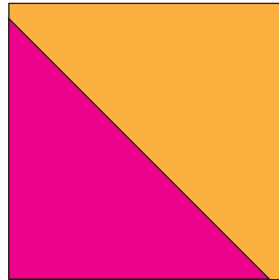
-  (8) - 4" SQUARES
-  (4) - 4.75" SQUARES
-  (4) - 4.5" SQUARES
-  (1) - 4.75" SQUARE

Match the lower left corner of a 4.75" square with one of the 4" squares.

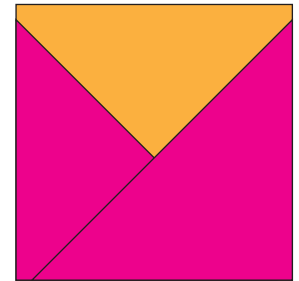


Stitch corner to corner.

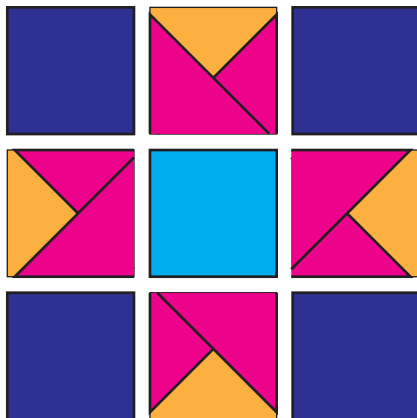
Fold Fabric over, matching the corners up. Press with your iron.



Repeat same process with right corner.



(Your finished piece should look like this.)



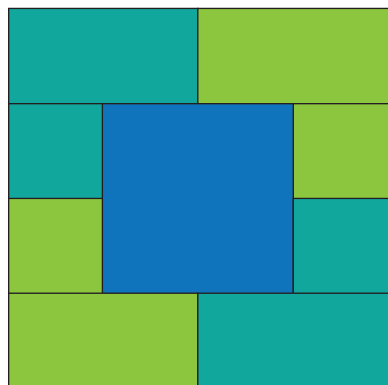
Arrange your pieces and sew together with a 1/4" seam.

Trim your final block to be 12.5" x 12.5".

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## Block #4



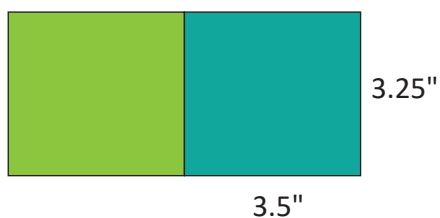
FINISHED SIZE: 12.5" X 12.5"

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

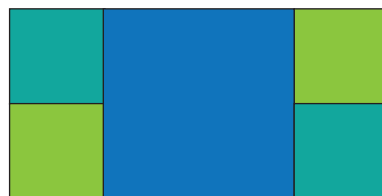
-  (2) - 6.5" X 3.5"  
(2) 3.5" X 3.25"
-  (2) - 6.5" X 3.5"  
(2) 3.5" X 3.25"
-  (1) - 6.5" SQUARE

*NOTE: This is a great place to fussy cut fabric!*

Starting with your smaller pieces, sew together the 3.25" sides using a 1/4" seam. Do this for both sets of small pieces.



Sew to the sides of your center square, making sure you alternate which fabric is on the top.



Sew together your rectangle pieces.



Attach to your center square and done!
